Stockmanship Programme 2023 - Junior

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Each team will consist of three members, each of whom must be under 19 years on the date of the Competition. All members must be full bona fide members of a club in the District he/she is representing which is affiliated to the Association. Please note that any member not able to compete on the day of the National Competition due to them reaching above the age limitation will be ineligible to compete in the preliminary rounds leading up to this event.
- 2. The competition will take place on the Saturday of the Royal Highland Show, at the show, commencing at 1.30 pm.
- 3. White coats must be worn by competitors.
- 4. The Junior "Stockman of the Year" will be ineligible to compete in the Junior programme again including the team competition. They can now however compete within the Senior programme.
- 5. Members of the winning team will not be eligible to compete in the Junior Competition in the following year.

PROCEDURE

- 1. The judging procedure laid down in "Know Your Farm Stock" will be followed.
- 2. In addition on completion of judging, competitors will be encouraged to listen to the sets of reasons or demonstrations being given publicly by the competitors in the Stockman of the Year competition.
- 3. The following breeds will be judged, subject to availability.
